Date of Death: — approx. 1890 (age about 50)

Occupation: Tutored children of rich Jewish families. Lived and traveled with them. Wrote this diary during a European trip. Wrote many other articles. To the best of my knowledge, never sold anything. The family was poor. (wife & 6 or 7 children) We were told that some of the writings can be found in the Jewish section of the Bronxville (Bronx, N.Y.) library. A cousin, Mrs. Brown, ^{lives at} spoke of a book (or books) of our grandfather in "a library" in Israel. (which one??)

About 15 years ago, I showed this diary to the late Dr. Bloch (N.Y. Pub. Lib. 42 St. — Jewish department) he was impressed & would have liked to have the book. *Поконася в арывах. Нашей два томіх журна, в которых были напечатаны статьи переведенные гедушкой с немецкого на древнееврейский язык.*
